The exhibition focusing on the River Cats baseball team's first season in West Sacramento presented by the West Sacramento Historical Society Museum and Visitors Center in conjunction with the River Cats Booster Club will close on August 1st. The show can be seen at the museum located at 324 Third Street in the Broderick district of West Sacramento. Various photographs and memorabilia highlighting the River Cats ground breaking ceremony and construction of Raley's Field in West Sacramento is displayed as well as other items from the first season. This year marks the sixth season for the River Cats to play in West Sacramento. Carol Edmonds and Dave Kelly of the River Cats Booster Club are assisting with the exhibition.

The River Cats franchise was purchased in 1998 and relocated to West Sacramento from Vancouver just prior to the 2000 season and were formerly named the Vancouver Canadians. In their first season as the River Cats, they won their first of 4 Pacific Coast League South Division titles. Sacramento's franchise has led all of Minor League Baseball in attendance during each of its five seasons at Raley Field.

The museum is open Thursday and Friday from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and Saturday and Sunday noon to 5:00 p.m. The museum is free, but donations are welcome.
